

How to order a Pet Portrait

A 6-step guide to ordering your pet portrait

Step 1: Choose the photo you want to have sketched

Provide a couple more photos of the dog you're asking me to sketch, if you can – this would allow me to really get to know the dog, the shape of their nose, the way their ears normally fall, the expression they most often pull, the behaviour of their fur, etc! It helps me to create an even more accurate portrait.


Step 2: Pick a size you would like your sketch to be

I keep 5 different paper sizes in stock at all time, but I am happy to work on any size that works for you. If you have a particular size in mind that isn't listed below, please let me know!

I can always crop my paper to a new size, or source some new paper to suit your needs.

Available Paper Sizes:

A6 - 4.1 x 5.8 inches A5 - 5.8 x 8.3 inches A4 - 8.3 x 11.7 inches A3 - 11.7 x 16.5 inches A2 - 16.5 x 23.4 inches





Step 3: Send me your photo(s) and chosen size


Send across the photo you have chosen for a sketch, the size you would like it to be, along with any accompanying pictures. Please include any additional details you may have; e.g if you require the sketch by a certain date, or if you would like to know prices for more than just one size or style!

Step 4: Receive a draft design and quote

You will receive a draft design along with a quote for your chosen image. Sometimes there will be multiple design options for the particular photo you have sent. I send all the best possible options across, along with an individual quotation for each.





Step 5: Pay a 25% deposit to secure your booking

Once you have decided you would like to go ahead with one of the draft designs, we can go ahead and book your order! All I require to secure your booking, is a 25% deposit. This can be paid via a direct bank transfer (BACS) or via PayPal (for a small fee). The final amount is not due until the sketch is completed, prior to shipping or collection.

Step 6: Sit back and wait for your bespoke art to be created!

As soon as I have made a start on your sketch, I will be in touch to let you know. I will also send across photo updates you keep you in the loop throughout the process! Once the sketch is completed, I will check you are 100% happy with the product before I package it up to ship.
